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The Program

The John & Olive Adams Foundation is a private family foundation established in 1961 for the purpose of helping students pursue post-secondary education at Idaho universities. The Adams Foundation will award scholarships to qualifying students who plan to further their education at a college or university accredited by the Northwest Commission of Colleges and Universities within the state of Idaho. This is a renewable scholarship for up to four years while enrolled in a qualifying institution and maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0. Applicant must be a **current high school senior and reside in Bonneville County**. The scholarship is intended for students who plan to study in the broad fields of **physical science or social science**.

Eligibility

Applicants must reside in Bonneville County, Idaho **and** qualify under at least **one** of the following:

- Top 20% of graduating class
- Score 24 on ACT or 1110 on SAT
- Cumulative unweighted GPA 3.5 or higher

Application

To apply, students must submit the following in duplicate (original and one copy):
A completed application form with applicant & parent or guardian signature including:

- Personal information sheet.
- A personal statement of no more than two double-spaced pages.
- Two letters of recommendation (one must be from a school administrator, counselor, teacher or other school official.)

Application Deadline

Applications are **due Wednesday, February 7, 2024** They may be submitted to a college and career advisor or school counselor no later than the close of school that day. Applications may also be mailed to:

Selection of Recipients

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the basis of information supplied. Emphasis will be placed upon student GPA, school/community involvement, citizenship, and future promise. All recipients will be notified of the results following our application evaluations in February. Award recipients are expected to attend all scholarship program events including a photo and video shoot in March as well as a recipient reception and awards ceremony in April.
